3) Route for joint ride with Tenby Aces on 10 April 2011

Andrew and Jon Mills agreed a route. Details on the forum

4) Routes in general

Andrew asked that the 'routes' on the web site are tidied up. They need to be grouped into distances and suitable for a Wednesday or Sunday ride. Ian to circulate copies of OS Maps of the area for people to mark up routes. These can then be reviewed and added to the site.

5) Future events – dates and locations

a. Civic Week

It was agreed that we would arrange a Cycloquiz of about 5 to 10 miles for the afternoon of the Sunday (24 July 2011). Aim is to solve cryptic clues along the route. We need to ensure that helmets are worn and that there is a minimum age below which children must be accompanied by an adult. Club members to marshal the route. Andrew to discuss with Liz Rogers

b. AGM

It was suggested an AGM should be called to elect a committee. A provisional date of Friday 17 June 2011 was agreed and Kim to see if we could use the Rugby Club as a venue. Jon Mills of Tenby Cycles to be invited (now



accepted) to give a talk on bike maintenance and Kim Griffith of Valley Gate Osteopathic Clinic to give a talk on stretching and massage.

c. Nick Brown

It was proposed that we arrange to go to Nick's Training Centre as a Club to train on the Watt Bikes. Andrew to discuss arrangements with Nick.

6) Club mechanise

a. Bottles

Ian has got a couple of sample 750ml water bottles from a manufacturer. It was agreed that we should get Leighton to provide a mock up of a black bottle with the Dynamos logo and name in red and white. Ian to the get a quote for 100 bottles, however, preliminary estimates suggest they would be £2.50 to £3.00 each. We could then sell them for say £4.00 to £5.00 to raise money for the Club.

b. Club jerseys

Ian to speak to Kenny at Fossa Sports to see how jersey sales were going. It was agreed that when we needed to order more jerseys the design should be changed to include the logo and web site address.

We will also see if Kenny is prepared to give some of his profit to the Club as he has his logo on the shirt. For instance, if we had the shirt manufacturer's logo on the sleeve then we would get a 5% discount. Andrew and Dylan to talk to Kenny at the appropriate time.

7) Carten 100 arrangements

Matthew has arranged for two minibuses (one for the bikes) to take us to Cardiff. There are currently 13 people who have said they will come in the minibus, however, 4 of the 13 may now be making their own arrangements. The plan is that we will be brought back to Narberth after the ride to get showered and changed and then taken back to Tenby for the evening do at the Rugby Club. The minibus will then bring everyone back at the end of the evening.

Matthew has suggested that the bikes are loaded up on the Friday evening.

Drivers are being arranged.



Matthew has not confirmed costs, but it was suggest that between £10.00 and £20.00 per person is allowed for petrol.
